## 2. Who is actually conducting the processing activity?

The data is processed together with an external third party.

In addition to internal staff, an external company providing physical security services (guarding services) monitors the video surveillance system at defined locations with qualified staff. The maintenance and administration of the video surveillance system is performed by external companies in a defined and controlled environment.

## 3. Purpose of the processing

The recognition system is put in place in order to control the access of vehicles to the premises of the ECB, as part of the security and safety concept of the ECB.

The recognition system aims at ensuring that only registered vehicles of ECB staff members are granted access to the ECB Main Building, Eurotower and Japan Center premises where the ECB staff parking area is located.

- -The ECB stores personal data related to vehicle registration for the duration of the employment of the staff member and for a period of one year after this relationship has been terminated.
- -The personal data captured by the cameras of the recognition system are not stored beyond the access procedure and are, as a rule, deleted immediately after the vehicle has been admitted to the staff members' garage.
